

## Grainger Inventors' Workshop Safety Agreement

Before you begin working in the Grainger Workshop, read and understand the Workshop rules that include Safety precautions for working safely in the workshop. Sign and date this agreement and return other Grainger Workshop Supervisor.

When I am in the Grainger Workshop I will:

1. wear approved eye, ear, and hand protection while working with any power tools;
2. wear approved eye protection when there exists a potential for eye injury;
3. remove jewelry and tie back long hair;
4. wear shoes and roll up long shirt sleeves;
5. work safely and conscientiously and never work alone;
6. know where first aid, fire, and safety equipment are located in the lab;
7. receive a safety orientation for each power tool and cutting hand tool I intend to use;
8. use tools only for their intended purpose;
9. never leave a power tool running unattended;
10. use only proper attachments for power tools;
11. assemble and disassemble power tool attachments carefully;
12. return all tools to their proper storage locations;
13. keep the workshop clean;
14. take immediate action as needed in response to accidents and injuries;
15. report all accidents, no matter how minor, to the workshop supervisor;
16. receive a safety orientation on electricity before working on an electrical project.

I have carefully read and fully understand all the safety precautions summarized above and recognize that it is my responsibility to observe their precautions at all times while in the Grainger Workshop.
