



The following are the planned offerings for the 2008 Summer Term. If insufficient registrations are received, IVHS reserves the right to not offer the course. All courses are regular semester courses, compressed into an 8-week period and are worth ½ Carnegie unit (i.e. 1 semester of credit). **Students taking a world language course may only take a single semester of content and may not take any other IVHS course during the summer.** For other subject areas, it is recommended that a student only take 1 course. If a student would like to attempt 2 courses, they may be approved for 1 course and the other course request will be placed in a waitlist status. If the student completes the first course within the first 4 weeks, the other course will be approved. Otherwise the course will be dropped without charge and the student will have the remaining 4 weeks to complete the first course. There are **NO EXTENSIONS** allowed in the summer term.
