

# Health Registration Requirements

## All Students

### Severe Food Allergy and Severe Non-Food Allergy

Please have your child's physician complete an Anaphylaxis Emergency Plan for food and/or non-food allergy (i.e. bee stings) that requires epinephrine (i.e. Epi-Pen, Auvi-Q).

### Asthma or Reactive Airway Disease

Please have your child's physician complete an Asthma Action Plan if your child uses an inhaler for asthma or reactive airway disease:

- Your child uses a daily controller/ maintenance medication as part of their treatment plan
- Your child uses prednisone as part of their treatment plan
- Your child ever needs to use a nebulizer machine
- Not required if your child only use a rescue inhaler (Albuterol, Xopenex) and have never required any other medications to treat their asthma/reactive airway symptoms

## Sophomores

Each student must submit a completed Certificate of Child Health Examination (school physical) including a complete immunization record, **signed by a physician and dated May 15, 2018 or later**, before move-in day on August 16, 2018.

## Seniors

Beginning with the school year 2015-2016, any child entering 12<sup>th</sup> grade shall show proof of receiving two doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine prior to entering the 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

- The first dose shall have been received on or after the 11<sup>th</sup> birthday
- The second dose shall have been at least eight weeks after the first dose
- If the first dose is administered when the child is 16 years of age or older, only one dose is required

You will be notified by email in April 2018 if your student needs proof of meningococcal immunization and a, **signed and dated by a physician** must be presented before move-in day on August 18, 2018 or early move-in day in order for your student to move into the residence hall.
