IMSA PAC MEETING MINUTES September 14, 2002 (Parents' Day)

President's Report

Vice President's Report

Cathy Barnes distributed out a chart showing how the state representatives voted for the IMSA budget to the parents.

Eric McLaren pointed out that representatives will not be considering budget issues again until March, 2003 and IMSA will be asking parents to contact their representatives at that time. He will also confirm that the chart accurately reflects the representatives' votes on the specific motion at issue and communicate that information to the parents.
