# NEED to KNOW -- INFORMATION for EXCEL 2014

There are no fees, tuition, or room and board to attend the Excel program.

The Excel Residential Coordinator, Claire Burke and three Resident Counselors live in the residence hall with the students. They will be available to you from 3:00 pm through the night, and will often be conducting programs, field trips, or discussions to help you understand your role as an IMSA student.

Faculty and staff will be available throughout the day. You will be in the Academic building between 7:45 and 4:00 pm. You are expected to handle yourself responsibly and reasonably in and out of class.

There is a nurse on campus every morning from Monday through Friday (she distributes prescription medications).

Security is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. These are responsible professionals whose job is to protect the safety and security of our students and staff, as well as the security of our facilities. They are very visible and will assist you at all times.

### WHERE WILL I LIVE? WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

You will be staying in the residence hall 1504 with a roommate, and four Resident Counselors (RC's). You need to bring just enough to survive for three weeks (see the **What to Bring to Excel** list). Casual clothes are appropriate, but plan on changeable weather and temperatures (including sometimes uneven air conditioning in the buildings). **You must have closed-toed shoes for laboratory work**, and gym shoes for the Teams Course. Meals will be provided three times a day during the week. Brunch and dinner may be scheduled on weekends.

You are NOT to bring your own computer. IMSA Computers will be provided during the three weeks of the summer Excel program.

### DO I NEED MONEY?

Most expenses for programmed activities will be taken care of, but there may be optional activities that cost money. Field trip admissions and food is covered, but you may wish to bring some money to buy souvenirs, snacks, etc. You will need cash if you plan to do laundry (\$1 through \$20 bills to load onto the laundry card). Again, you may wish to bring a small amount of spending money, but it is not required.
