When will I receive my invitation?

We plan to send the formal invitations electronically in mid March 2017. The RSVP deadline will be in April. We encourage you to RSVP promptly to secure seating. The invitations will list the menu options you can select from.

What is the cost to families?

Tickets are \$50 each, and \$25 per child (aged 12 and younger, selecting a meal from the children's menu). Financial assistance may be available for the graduating student. Please contact Dr. Robert Hernandez in the Student Life Office for more information regarding financial assistance.

How many tickets can I order?

At this time we plan to open the process with the Graduate plus 3 guests, for a total of 4 tickets. You will receive your invitation via email, with the link to purchase banquet tickets on or about March 28, 2017. Requests for additional tickets will be placed on a waitlist. We will monitor this closely, and open up the wait list later in April. We do not envision a problem in clearing the waitlist as the facility can accommodate a sizeable banquet.

When will I receive my tickets?

You will receive an email confirmation receipt of your RSVP and payment; however, banquet tickets will **NOT** be mailed to your home. **You will pick up your tickets at the Senior Banquet during registration.** Please make note of this.

How do students get to and from the 2017 Senior Banquet?

Most graduates travel by car with their families. Students may also arrange transportation for themselves through the Student Life Office.

Can my family stay overnight?

The Embassy Suites has set aside a block of rooms at discounted rates. This includes their free made-to-order breakfast in their onsite restaurant Brickstones. Embassy Suites will open the breakfast service at 6:30am (half an hour before their usual opening time) on Jun 04 to ensure you can get to the Paramount for the graduation ceremony on time. These rates are available until May 8, 2017.
