IMSA PROMISE - Leading Students 2 Success (LS2S) is a collaborative learning
program for current 5 th , 6 th , 7 th and 8 th graders, designed to expose students to STEM
(Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) related experiences as well as introduce
them to inquiry and problem-based learning. Through a process of discussion and
analytical exploration of mathematical and scientific concepts, LS2S will assist students
in developing their academic and interpersonal skills. This program occurs on 8
Saturdays from 8:00am – 1:30pm during the months of October through January.

□ IMSA PROMISE - Early Involvement Program (EIP) serves students enrolled in 9th grade. The program includes discovery-based and collaborative research activities as well as some preparation for the Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT). Students develop critical thinking, decision-making and leadership skills while studying mathematics and science. This program occurs on 10 Saturdays from 8:00am – 1:30pm during the months of October through January.
