Resolution:	Equivalent to 4x6 photo printed at 300dpi (1200px x 1800px) or larger
File Naming:	(Lastname)(Firstname)(Child's Age in Photo).jpg

5. When will I receive my invitation?

We plan to send the formal invitations electronically on **March 21, 2019**. The RSVP will be April 7, 2019. We encourage you to RSVP promptly to secure seating. The invitations will list the menu options you can select from.

6. What is the cost to families?

Tickets are \$50 each, and \$25 per child (aged 12 and younger, selecting a meal from the children's menu).

Financial assistance may be available for the graduating student. Please contact Katie Berger in the Student Life Office at kberger@imsa.edu for more information regarding financial assistance.

7. How many tickets can I order?

At this time, we plan to open the process with Graduate plus 3 guests, for a total of 4 tickets. Requests for additional tickets (up to 3) will be placed on a waitlist. We will monitor this closely, and open up the waitlist later in the process. We do not envision a problem in clearing the waitlist as the facility can accommodate a sizeable banquet.

You will receive email confirmation of both your RSVP and payment. However, banquet tickets will not be emailed to your home. You will pick up your tickets at the Senior Banquet during check in at 5pm on the day of the event. Please make a note of this.

8. How do students get to and from the 2019 Senior Banquet?

Graduates may either travel by car with their families, or take bus transportation that will be provided from/to IMSA. Students may also arrange transportation for themselves through the Student Life Office.

9. Can my family stay overnight?

Sheraton Lisle Naperville has set aside a block of rooms at discounted rates.

All meal choices made during registration are final.

Again, it is important that guests stay at their originally assigned seats until dinner is served, to avoid delays in delivering the meals. If the wait staff cannot find you, they cannot serve you!
