Grants from the Fund that consist of individual contributions may have purpose restrictions imposed by the donors ("IMSA Fund - Restricted" or SPM Endowment), or they may not have any donor restrictions ("IMSA Fund - Unrestricted"), although the Fund itself may impose restrictions on the Academy regarding the use of the latter. All other grants are identified by their original source, whether government entity or private foundation.
