

### **Downloading the Installation File(s)**

- Go to <https://imsa.edu/scs>
- Click on the download link for the Installation/Setup for Windows OS
  - **Science Class Requirement: Logger Pro**

- Click the Dropbox download button




- Make sure Save File is selected (if prompted) and click OK



- Click Save to download the file to your Downloads folder on your Windows computer
- Close the pop-up windows and the web browser

## Extract the Installation Files

- Go to your downloads folder and open it so you can see the contents
- Find and right-click on the downloaded file (Install-LoggerPro.zip) and select Extract All from the pop-up menu




- Click Extract to accept the default extract location. Note the location, as you will need it in the next step.



## Installing IMSA Verner Logger Pro Client

- Navigate to the location noted above and double-click on the directory/folder to open it.
  - A window may automatically open to this location, depending on your Windows OS configuration.
- Double-click on the Install-LoggerPro folder
- Launch the installer, **installApplication (Run as Administrator).cmd**. Right-click and select Run as Administrator.



- Click Yes when prompted to confirm running the installer.
- You will see a Windows protected your PC prompt. Click on the More Info Link



- Click the Run anyway button




- You will see a User Account Control prompt, select Yes to allow the configuration script to run



- The installer will run in the back ground for a few seconds with minimum activity on screen, you may see the following while installing the base package
