BACKPACKS, COMPUTER BAGS, COOLERS, DUFFEL BAGS, CAMERA BAGS, PURSES LARGER THAN PERMISSIBLE CLUTCH, ANY BAG LARGER THAN THE PERMISSIBLE SIZE. ALL BAGS ARE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION.

- A clear bag policy has been implemented and is enforced at the Convocation Center. The following are permitted:
 - Bags that are clear and do not exceed 12" x 12" x 6".
 - o Small purses which do not exceed 5.5" x 8.5" and no more than 3" thick.
 - An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection at the door.
- Flowers are permitted in the Center. Flowers with a glass vase will not be allowed in the venue.
- Gifts that can be properly searched are permitted in the Convocation Center. Any gifts that are wrapped/sealed will be asked to be returned to your vehicle.
- Banners and signs are allowed provided they are hand-held of reasonable size, can be stored beneath the seat and do not block the view of other patrons.
- Outside food or drink is not permitted. It is permissible for guests to bring into the Convocation Center
 one bottled water, provided it is in a clear plastic commercial container (such as an Aquafina bottle)
 no larger than 1 liter that has not been opened or that is empty of its contents.
 Frozen bottles are prohibited.
 - Please refrain from bringing in any other outside beverages (including Starbucks, Dunkin', and other coffee brands).
